UHF Radio Channel Allocation

1 to 8 - These channels, which are established by law, can be used when sending a signal to a repeater which will help increase the communication distance

5 - This channel, which is established by law, can be used by anyone but only in an emergency situation

9 - Used for conversations

10 - Used by 4WD enthusiasts, clubs, convoys and in national parks

11 - Calling channel. This channel, which is established by law, is used to call or locate another station. Parties will then switch to another channel to continue with their conversation

12 to 17 - Used for conversations

18 - Holiday maker's communication channel (e.g. when in a convoy)

19 to 21 - Used for conversations

22 and 23 - These two channels are used for data transmissions and is established by law. Voice transmissions are not allowed on these two channels

24 to 30 - Used for conversations

29 - Highway Communications which are mainly used by truck drivers and other highway users

31 to 38 - These channels, which are established by law, are received by a repeater and re-transmitted on channels 1 to 8 to help increase the communication distance

35 - Can be used in case of Emergencies also

39 - Used for conversations

40 - Highway Communications which are mainly used by truck drivers and other highway users

Hi Fellow 4WDer's,

Opposite Lock Adelaide is putting on a 4WD Event on the Saturday of the 16th April 2011.

The Event is to be called the 4x4xKROOZE.

It is aimed at attracting Entrants from all facets of the 4WD community. It is to be a Show and Shine style Event featuring primarily static displays of Private 4WDs and Ramp Travel Index competitions for drivers to test the limits of their suspension flex.

We will offer display spaces for any and all road registered 4WDs, or Groups/Clubs of 4WDs, that the proud owners want to show off. Groups must be a minimum of 4 vehicles.

The venue is Wigley Reserve in Glenelg, a council maintained, lushly grassed and partly shaded parkland near the foreshore at one of SA's Premier beachside locations.

The day starts with a static display of vehicles, allowing everybody to mingle and the public to view the vehicles with the owners present.

This will coincide with judging of vehicles in 10 different categories. With Over \$5000 worth of prizes.

4x4xKROOZE (the 'Event') Entry Terms And Conditions:

- All Entrant Vehicles must be Road registered, and be driven to the Event, unless otherwise invited by Organisers.
- Entry is for one 4WD Vehicle per Entrant, inc up to 2 persons. Trailers/Campers, bikes/ATV's, etc are not permitted.
- All Entries must be fully paid 14 days before the Event. No refunds permitted under any circumstances after 21 days prior to the Event scheduled date. A non-refundable administration fee of \$10.00 applies. All fees include GST.
- In the event of inclement weather, or other uncontrollable event, the Organisers may cancel or postpone the Event.
- All vehicles must be at the Event between 10.45 & 11.45am, ready to be positioned and ready for judging/RTI. Entrants arriving after this time will be refused vehicle entry to the Event.
- The Event is a static display. Unless permitted by an Event Official all vehicles must remain in position for the duration of the Event (Noon to 5pm). Movements are only permitted for RTI judging, or exiting the Event area at the completion of the Event.
- Entrants are not permitted to display or promote products other than the entered vehicle.
- Requests for reservations of a Group Area must at least of 30 days prior to the Event. Minimum of 4 vehicles applies.
- Any damage/losses caused to/by/from vehicles and/or persons, and/or other property before, during, and after, the Event, or any Event Activities, is the sole responsibility of the Entrant.
- The Organisers will endeavour to make sure all vehicles are safe during the Event, however the Organisers or the Sponsors can/will not take any responsibility for any damages to vehicles or personal property during the duration of the Event.
- Council Rulings:
 - > The Event Area is a Designated Dry Zone. No alcohol is permitted. Please do not bring glass containers.
 - > All persons entering the Event area must comply with Council Requirements & By-Laws.
 - > The Entrant is solely responsible for damage to any Council Property (including grassed areas).
 - > No animals will be allowed into the event as per Council Policy.
 - > Offensive or inappropriate behaviour may result in legal action and/or exclusion from the Event.
- All persons attending the Event must obey directions made by the Event Organisers & Officials.
- The Organisers reserve the right to use photographs and other stored media for promotional purposes.
- Failure to comply with the Terms & Conditions will result in exclusion from the Event.
